Technical University, Hamirpur. This fee is non-refundable and, will be adjusted towards final payment of fee at the respective institute.

#### 1. Introduction

The Himachal Pradesh Technical University was established with the objectives for value creation and welfare in society through technical education and training, research, innovation, public and private sector consultancy, entrepreneurship, continuing education programs, autonomous Colleges/Institution and affiliating Constituent and Private Colleges/Institutions. At the same time, the University is responsive to the changing and exceptional requirements of our society and economy and contribute to find answers to global problems.

This implies the continued existence and evolution of the University–defined by a commitment to offering society need-based and research-based technical education to increasingly diverse student bodies, to strengthening the linkage between teaching-learning and research, and to providing the University students with competences required to rapidly changing skilled labour markets. This requires the University with different traditions, vision, mission mixes, and thrust areas in the context of a system of higher education Institutions incorporating progression routes from one institution to another, based on equality of esteem for diverse missions, and aware of the importance of balancing the need for competitiveness with that of enhanced cooperation, social cohesion and solidarity.

#### 2. State Level Common Entrance Examination

Under the provisions of Section 5 of the Himachal Pradesh Private Technical and Vocational Education Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Fixation of Fee) Act, 2008 and in pursuance to the Notification No. EDN(TE)A(1)-9/2012 dated 16<sup>th</sup> March, 2013 and letter No. EDN(TE)A(9)1/2012 dated 29<sup>th</sup> November, 2013 issued by the Secretary (Technical Education) to the Government of Himachal Pradesh, Shimla, the Himachal Pradesh Technical University (A State Government University) will conduct State Level Common Entrance Examination for admission to First Year of B. Pharmacy Degree Course for all professional institutions in the State for the academic session 2014-15.

The candidates willing to take admission in affiliating institutes of Himachal Pradesh Technical University, Hamirpur need not to apply separately. They are advised to attend the counselling on the date(s), place and venue as mentioned in this prospectus.

### 2.1 INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES WILLING TO TAKE ADMISSION IN ANY PRIVATE UNIVERSITY OF HIMACHAL PRADESH:

The admission to B. Pharmacy Course in Private Universities in Himachal Pradesh shall be made on the basis of score/marks obtained by the candidate (s) in the State Level Common Entrance Examination (SLCEE) to be conducted by Himachal Pradesh Technical University.

The candidates desirous of seeking admission in Private Universities in Himachal Pradesh shall have to apply on the prescribed application form

available on the official website of each Private University along-with score/marks obtained in SLCEE-2014 conducted by the H.P. Technical University, Hamirpur within the stipulated period as decided by the Private Universities. Therefore, such candidate is advised to visit the official website of each University to have detailed information about the Private Universities and seats available with them in Himachal Pradesh.

### 3. Affiliating Institutes of Himachal Pradesh Technical University, Hamirpur, District Hamirpur (H.P.)

The following colleges/institutions are provisionally affiliated to H.P. Technical University on year to year basis. The brief description including the contact address, webpage, contact nos. etc. is given below for ready reference. The admission to B.Pharmacy first year (direct entry) of these institutes for the academic session 2014-2015 shall be made through State Level Common Entrance Examination being conducted by Himachal Pradesh Technical University and for 2<sup>nd</sup> year (under lateral entry scheme) shall be made strictly on the basis of merit of marks obtained by the candidates in Diploma in Pharmacy.

- Admission of the candidates in the above mentioned institutions is subject to Affiliation, Continuation/Approval, timely deposit of relevant affiliation fee, inspection fee, other University fees and counselling fee etc. and satisfactory report submitted by the Expert Committee constituted by H.P. Technical University for continuation of affiliation.

### 4. Academic facilities at affiliating institutes

H.P. Technical University is constantly striving towards achieving high standards of teaching, training and development of human resources by persuading the constituent and affiliated colleges to encourage their faculty and staff to work as a team and to update their knowledge and skills continually to match the needs of industry. University is laying emphasis on the faculty development by colleges through workshops on special topics, to participate in seminars and conferences, to design and conduct the workshops and seminars on the college premises.

The perspective candidates are advised to visit the website of respective institute to seek first hand information of the facilities such as:-

- Well qualified faculty including eminent Senior Professors in all departments having qualifications and teaching experience.
- Well equipped laboratories with State-of-the art equipment.
- Excellent computational and support facilities in the form of a Local Area Network and connectivity leased-line internet connectivity with minimum 2 mbps (1:1).
- An English Language Laboratory with latest computer machines and special software package to provide a self-paced, interactive learning environment for improvement of communication and writing skills.
- Excellent library facilities with subscription of hard copy and soft copy International, National technical journals, in concerned disciplines, standard text and reference books, periodicals, magazines and newspapers.
- Well furnished seminar hall with excellent audio and projection facilities along with class rooms with proper sitting ambience for imparting instructions.

The candidates before seeking admission should assess the institute on the basis of instructional facilities, teaching faculty members, sports facilities and extra-curricular activities available at the campus. The colleges are continuously encouraged to regularly update their websites.

### 5. Attendance and Discipline in Affiliating Institute (s)

- 5.1 Students are expected to maintain discipline within the institute campus & follow the instructions issued by the administration from time to time.
- 5.2 Students must attend 100% classes once registered in a course. Minimum atleast, 75% attendance in all theory & practical classes separately is mandatory for all students to make them eligible to appear in University examination. A student who fails to maintain 75% attendance shall not be allowed to sit in end semester examination.
- 5.3 No condonation of attendance on any ground shall be allowed.
- 5.4 No Fine shall be imposed by the institutes for absentees.

### 6. Placement Cell at Affiliating Institute (s)

Every institute offering technical and professional education degree must have a Placement Cell and Industry Institute Interaction Cell. The Placement Cell must have a Senior and qualified Officer as Head, who can render advice, assistance and guidance to students for industrial counselling, various facilities available from different Government and Quasi-Government Institutions for starting industrial projects, counselling for higher studies and foreign travel, project placement, short term industrial courses in various Government Undertakings, industrial visits, extension lectures, campus interviews and final placements. The details of the companies visiting the college for placements and the number of students placed through the Placement Cell of respective college can be checked by perspective students on the website of respective colleges. Each college is expected to maintain records of the placement of their students on the college website.

### 7. Admission Criteria (Fresh Entry) & Eligibility:-

Minimum eligibility criteria for admission to 1<sup>st</sup> Year of B. Pharmacy Course is as under:-

- 7.1 The candidate must have passed 10+2 examination with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with Mathematics or Biotechnology or Biology subject with at least 45% marks (40% in case of candidate belonging to reserved category) in the above subjects taken together.
- 7.2 The candidate must appear in State Level Common Entrance Examination.
- 7.3 However, the candidates who have appeared in 10+2 examinations and the result has not yet been declared may also appear in the State Level Common Entrance Examination, but the selection of such candidates will be subject to fulfillment of the minimum eligibility criteria as mentioned under para 7.1 and 7.2 above.
  - Note: (i) Pass in 10+2 from National Open School (N.O.S.), New Delhi with above mentioned subject shall not be considered as an entry qualification for admission to B. Pharmacy Degree Course (PCI letter No. 14-2/2007-PCI-13142 dated 27<sup>th</sup> December, 2007)
- 7.4 The selection of candidates will be made on the basis of merit of State Level Common Entrance Examination conducted by H.P. Technical University, Hamirpur for session 2014-15.
- 7.5 **Tuition Fee Waiver Seats in affiliating institutes**—Under this scheme 5% seats over and above the sanctioned intake shall be filled up amongst the bonafide/domicile Himachali candidates belonging to IRDP, BPL, Antodaya & Orphan families.
  - Provided the seats remain vacant after filling seats as above, the same shall be filled with candidates, whose family annual income is less than Rs. 2.50 lakhs from all sources. The candidate has to produce relevant valid certificates issued by the Competent Authority at the time of counselling
- 7.6 **Kashmiri Migrants seats in affiliating institutes**-Bonafide/domicile requirement shall be waived off.
- 7.7 **Beti Hai Anmol seat in affiliating institutes:** For the candidate who is "single girl child". The parent has to submit an affidavit attested by Executive Magistrate specifically stating that the parent has only single girl child and has no other living son and/or daughter. The scheme is for Bonafide/domicile Himachali candidates only.
- 8. Admission Criteria (Lateral Entry) & Eligibility in Affiliating Institutions of Himachal Pradesh Technical University
  - 8.1 For Lateral Entry (3<sup>rd</sup> Semester): Admission under this scheme will be made strictly on the basis of merit of marks obtained in diploma in Pharmacy.
  - 8.2 Educational Qualification for Lateral Entry Seats (3<sup>rd</sup> Semester): The candidates who have passed Diploma in Pharmacy from an approved institution; with at least 45% marks (40% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) will be eligible for admission directly in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester of second year regular B. Pharmacy Course under lateral entry. Those candidates who have appeared in final year diploma examination and their results have not yet been declared must bring final results from the respective Board at the time of counselling failing which their claim for admission will be null and void.

8.3 Preference shall be given to bonafide/domicile Himachali Diploma holders for admission under lateral entry. The candidates from other States may be considered for admission under lateral entry in case Himachali bonafide candidates are not available subject to fulfillment of all other eligibility conditions.

10.4 The domicile requirement condition has been waived off in respect of wards of Defence Personnel posted in Himachal Pradesh vide letter No. EDN(TE)B(15)4/2004-II dated 13.10.2010 with the condition that they should have passed the qualifying examination from H.P. Board of School Education.

11.2 Fee/funds including hostel rent and mess charges for the academic session 2014-15 in respect of Government and Private Un-Aided Pharmacy Colleges affiliated with Himachal Pradesh Technical University are to be charged by the Institutions in accordance with the notifications issued by the Government of Himachal Pradesh vide No. EDN(TE)A(1)-8/2005-II dated 25.04.2013, EDN(TE)A(1)-8/2005-II dated 9<sup>th</sup> April, 2013 and EDN(TE)A(1)-8/2005-II dated 15.3.2011. The above notifications issued by the Government are available on the official website of the university i.e. www.himtu.ac.in.

### 11.3 The above fees/funds/charges shall subject to the following terms and conditions:-

- (a) No Institution will charge any amount over and above the fee structure fixed herein and any violation in this regard would tantamount to charging capitation fee inviting de-recognition and dis-affiliation of the defaulting institution.
- (b) The institution concerned has to appoint sufficient number of teaching faculty and other supporting staff strictly as per the norms of University Grants Commission/H.P. Technical University. The ratio of Professor, Associate Professors and Assistant Professor must be maintained as (1:2:8).
- (c) The Institution has to ensure that quality and hygienic food is provided to the students and weekly menu is displayed on the Mess Notice Board. It may also be ensured that kitchen and dining hall are neat and clean.
- (d) The deficiencies pointed out by the Expert Committee need to be removed before the start of next academic session.
- (e) Every institution is required to issue proper receipt to every student for having received the fees and other charges mentioning therein.

(a) The selected candidates have to deposit the fees and other dues in the respective institute at the time of admission as specified in schedule/selection letter.

- (b) The College shall not charge higher fee or levy any charges other than those mentioned in the prospectus otherwise penalty will be imposed by the University.
- (c) If a student fails to deposit the fee and other dues as per the schedule, the college authority under special circumstances can allow the students to deposit the fee with prior approval from the University indicating a valid reason.
- (d) The College shall be solely responsible for the settlement of any dispute, court case, etc. arising out of such admissions.
- (e) The University fee for the 1<sup>st</sup> Year shall be deposited by all colleges in H.P. Technical University latest by 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2014 and for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Year the university fee shall be deposited by all the concerned colleges in the University every year latest by 10<sup>th</sup> October, failing which a penalty as decided by University from time to time will be imposed.

### 14 Withdrawal of admission by candidate of affiliating institutes and refund of fee thereof

#### 14.1 Procedure for withdrawal

- (a) A candidate who has been allotted a seat in central counselling can surrender the seat by adopting below mentioned procedure:-
  - (i) In person by submitting application to the Chairman, Admission Committee.
  - (ii) By submitting application through fax No. 01972-224150 to the University and in person at the institute allotted.

### 14.2 The following rules shall govern the refund of fee in case of withdrawal of admission:

- (a) If any candidate is allotted a seat in the central counselling and after acceptance, if he/she refuses/surrenders the seat and informs the Chairman, Admission Committee, personally in writing, before the last round of counselling, the entire fee collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing fee of not more than Rs.1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) shall be refunded and returned by the Institution to the student/candidate withdrawing from the programme within three days from the date of issue of such directions from the University.
- (b) No fee and other charges except refundable securities will be refunded to the candidate who will surrender the seat after last round of counselling, subject to the condition that the seat vacated by him/her is not filled up.

The entrance examination for B. Pharmacy Degree Course shall be conducted by the Himachal Pradesh Technical University at different examination centres as per the notified date in the prospectus. The Roll Numbers/Admit card to eligible candidates will be available on the website of the University and the candidates are advised to download the same from Himachal Pradesh Technical University website <a href="www.himtu.ac.in">www.himtu.ac.in</a> after verification of his/her credentials.

Admit card duly initialled by the invigilator will be retained by the candidate after the test is over.

- (a) Section-A shall contain 50 questions in the subjects of Physics and each question shall carry one mark.
- (b) Section-B shall contain 50 questions in the subject of Chemistry and each question shall carry one mark.
- (c) Section-C shall contain 50 questions from Mathematics or Biology (as optional). A candidate with Mathematics background shall attempt Mathematics part and candidate with Biology background shall attempt Biology part. In case of candidate, studying both subjects in 10+2, it shall be the choice of candidate to either attempt Biology part or the Mathematics part. A candidate has to attempt one part. Each question shall carry one mark.
- (d) There shall be no negative marking.
- (e) The pattern of question paper will be multiple choice questions (MCQ) type. The language of question papers will be English.

### 15.3 Syllabus for Examination

The syllabus for the entrance examination shall be same as prescribed by NCERT, New Delhi for 10+1 and 10+2. The name of units of NCERT syllabi are reproduced as below:

### 10+1 Units

Diversity in Living World, Structural Organisation in Animals and Plants, Structure and Function, Plant Physiology, Human Physiology.

### 10+2 Units

Reproduction, Genetics and Evolution, Biology and Human Welfare, Biotechnology, Ecology.

### (iv) Mathematics

### 10+1 Units

Sets, relations and functions, trigonometric functions, principle of mathematical induction, linear inequities, permutations and combinations, binomial theorem, sequences and series, straight lines, conic sections, introduction to three dimensional geometry, limits and derivatives mathematical reasoning, statistics, probability.

### 10+2 Units

Relations and functions, inverse trigonometric functions, matrices, determinants, Continuity and differentiability, application of derivatives, integrals, application of integrals, differential equations, vector algebra, three dimensional geometry, linear programming, probability.

### 15.4 Result and Merit List

- (a) The result alongwith marks in respect of all the candidates appearing in the State Level Common Entrance Examination will be declared and displayed on the University Notice Board and will also be available on the University's website <a href="www.himtu.ac.in">www.himtu.ac.in</a>. The result of each candidate will be provisional. The detail of marks can be obtained from the University website.
- (b) The merit shall be determined on the basis of aggregate number of marks obtained in the entrance examination by the candidates and the merit list will be prepared accordingly. The inter-se ranking of the candidates obtaining equal aggregate marks in the competitive examination shall be in order of preference as below:

- (i) All the applicants who have been selected for admission shall have to pay the requisite fee at the time of admission in respective college.
- (j) Applicants seeking admission to affiliating institutes need not apply again to the individual institute.
- (k) The certificates/documents attached, if any, alongwith hard copy of application form will not be returned to the candidate or his/her nominee, in case he/she does not get admission.
- (I) Applications received after the last date will not be considered. The University shall not be responsible for any postal delay for any reason.
- (m) Wrong or misleading or ambiguous entry in the application form may lead to the rejection of the application without assigning any reason.
- (n) No intimation will be sent to those applicants who fail to get admission and no correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
- (o) The applicant should clearly mention in his/her application form whether he/she belongs to any of the reserved categories and whether he/she is applying for seats reserved for that category. If, no category is mentioned then the application will be considered against General Category.
- (p) Admission shall be made strictly as per 200 point's roster approved by the Government of Himachal Pradesh.
- (q) If no candidate is available in any category, in such case the seat will be offered/filled as per merit of rank/marks from amongst the next point/category falling in the roster.
- (r) If any candidate has concealed, suppressed or distorted any information/fact which would render him/her ineligible for admission, his/her admission shall stand cancelled and he/she will have no claim, whatsoever against the College/Government/H.P. Technical University.
- 17.2 The candidate shall be solely responsible for any data given in Online Application Form.
- 17.3 Seats reserved for the applicants belonging to the Backward Areas as notified by the Government of H.P. from time to time will be allotted in the following manner/order (subject to the production of certificate in the format available in the prospectus)

- (a) Applicants who have passed at least two examinations i.e. Primary/Middle/High/+2 from a school located in the backward area.
- (b) If no such eligible candidate is available, those who have passed at least one examination i.e. Primary/Middle/High/+2 from a school located in the backward area.
- (c) If no such eligible candidate is available, those who have passed such two examinations from the immediately adjoining area shall be considered against this quota.
- (d) If no such eligible candidate is available, those who have passed such one examination from the immediately adjoining area shall be considered against this quota.
- (e) If no such applicant is available then an applicant from Backward Area who has not passed any exam from backward area, but belongs to backward area shall be considered.
- (f) If no such eligible applicant becomes available from the Backward Area for the seat so reserved, the seat will go to its main category.

## 17.4 Instructions to the candidates applying under Backward Area, Defence and Sports Sub-Category for First Year of B. Pharmacy Course:-

Only those Backward Area and Defence Certificates will be taken into account for preparing separate merit list under backward area and defence sub categories which are produced by the candidate in person before the Expert Committee for verification of genuineness on 5.6.2014. Additional Backward Area and Defence Certificates submitted after due date will not be considered for preparing the merit list against backward area and defence subcategories.

The verification of genuineness of the Backward Area and Defence Category certificates will be assessed at Himachal Pradesh Technical University, Gandhi Chowk, Hamirpur, District Hamirpur (H.P.) on 5.6.2014 at 10.00 A.M. by the Expert Committee constituted by the University. All the candidates applying under backward area and defence sub-category must be present in person before the Expert Committee along with all original backward area and defence certificates and supporting documents as well as one photocopied set of these certificates duly attested by the Gazetted Officer as per above schedule. Only those candidates, who will get their backward area and defence certificates assessed by the Expert Committee, will be considered for admission against backward area and defence category on the day of counselling.

- (a) Only those authenticated sports certificates will be taken into account for preparing separate merit list which are produced by the candidate in person before the Expert Committee for verification of genuineness on 6.6.2014. Additional sports certificates or authenticated sports certificates submitted after due date will not be considered for preparing the sports merit.
- (b) The verification of genuineness of the sports certificates will be assessed by the Expert Committee constituted by the Director, Youth Services and Sports Department. Shimla (H.P.) at Himachal Pradesh Technical University, Gandhi Chowk, Hamirpur, District Hamirpur (H.P.) on 6.6.2014 at 10.00 A.M. All sports category candidates must be present in person before the Expert Committee along with all original sports certificates as well as one photocopied set of sports certificates duly attested by the Gazetted Officer as per above schedule. Only those candidates who will get their sports certificates assessed by the Expert Committee, will be considered for admission against sports category.

## 17.6 Instructions to the candidates applying under Backward Area, Defence and Sports Sub-Category for 2<sup>nd</sup> year of B. Pharmacy Course under Lateral Entry Scheme:

- (a) Only those Backward Area, Defence and authenticated sports Certificates will be taken into account for preparing separate merit list under backward area, defence and sports sub-categories which are produced by the candidate in person before the Expert Committee for verification of genuineness on 24.7.2014. Additional Backward Area, Defence and Sports Certificates submitted after due date will not be considered for preparing the merit list against backward area, defence and sports sub-categories.
- (b) The verification of genuineness of the relevant certificates will be assessed at Himachal Pradesh Technical University, Gandhi Chowk, Hamirpur, District Hamirpur (H.P.) on 24.7.2014 at 10.00 A.M. by the Expert Committee constituted by the University. All the candidates applying under backward area, defence and sports sub-category must be present in person before the Expert Committee along with all original relevant certificates as well as one photocopied set of certificates duly attested by the Gazetted Officer as per above schedule. Only those candidates, who will get their relevant certificates assessed by the Expert Committee, will be considered for admission against backward area, defence and sports sub-category on the day of counselling.
- 17.7 The Controller of Admissions shall ensure that the Director, Youth Services & Sports, H.P. be informed for assessment of various types of sports certificates well before the date of sports certificate verification.

17.8 A separate merit list of the sports category candidates will be prepared and merit shall be determined by giving additional weightage in lieu of the grading of the best or the highest sports event played by the applicant to the marks obtained by him/her in the entrance examination/qualifying examination. Only those certificates will be considered for calculation of sports merit, which are issued by the sports authorities mentioned above. The sports merit so calculated will be applicable for determining the merit in respect of sports category only and not for any other category. The mode of grant of additional weightage will be as under: -

17.9 Admission to Management Seats - The counselling/admission to the management seats is to be conducted/made by college management within the stipulated period as per the final judgement of Hon'ble Supreme Court in order No. CA-9048 of 2012 dated 13<sup>th</sup> December, 2012. The College management is required to give an advertisement in at least two leading newspapers (in Hindi and English version) having widest circulation in the State and outside the State for inviting applications for filling up of Management Quota seats with clear-cut mention of last date of receipt of application form and schedule for counselling in the said advertisement.

The candidates who are interested to seek admission under Management Quota Seats shall have to apply in the concerned Private Affiliating College by downloading the result card of the State Level Common Entrance Examination-2014.

The college management is required to admit only those candidates who fulfil the minimum eligibility criteria mentioned in the Prospectus-Cum-Information Brochure 2014.

NOTE: In pursuance of the final judgement of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in order No. CA-9048 of 2012 dated 13<sup>th</sup> December, 2012, last date to which the students can be admitted against vacancies arising due to any reason (no student should be admitted in any institution after the last date under any quota) is 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2014. However, any round of counselling could be conducted depending on local requirements, but all the rounds shall be completed before 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2014.

- 17.11 Every college is required to display the admission data on the above proforma on the official website of the college, failing which strict action will be taken against the concerned college by the University.
- 17.12 The College shall not change any of the provisions contained in the prospectus (including eligibility, fees or rules for refund) while granting such admissions.
- 17.13 **Penalty clause**: In case any institution admits candidates by violating the standard admission norms laid down in this prospectus, the concerned institution will be fined @ Rs. 10,000/- per candidate and the candidate admitted by the institution in violation of laid down admission norms will not be considered for registration with University.

### 18. PROCEDURE OF ADMISSION FOR ALL CANDIDATES IN AFFILIATING COLLEGE (S) OF H.P. TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY

- 18.1 Only those applicants who have filled up **Online** application form and submitted the **hard copy alongwith payment receipt** to the Himachal Pradesh Technical University on or before the last date and time and satisfy the eligibility criteria, will be considered for admission strictly in order of merit/rank of entrance examination/qualifying examination.
- 18.2 Separate merit list shall be prepared for all the reserved categories.
- 18.3 Admission shall be offered to the applicants of reserved categories before that of general category. Unclaimed/vacant seat, if any, from the reserved categories shall be transferred to the general category at the end of the admission round of reserved category. Claim of the applicants of reserved category who remain absent for any round of counselling, shall not be accepted for the seats so transferred.
- 18.4 Physical presence of the applicant is necessary at the time of admission and counselling. The parents/guardian of the applicant will be allowed to accompany the applicant to enable him/her to select course and/or institution of his/her choice out of available courses.
- 18.5 An applicant listed in the merit list shall be eligible for all rounds of admissions/counselling, irrespective of whether he/she attended/availed admission in the earlier round or not.
- 18.6 An applicant who is eligible for admission in more than one category will be admitted in the category of his/her choice subject to availability of seats. However, he/she will be entitled for vertical mobility under all the eligible categories subject to availability of seats. The vertical mobility of the candidate will be from sub reserved category to corresponding Main Reserved Category and then to Main General Category.
- 18.7 If an applicant after having been admitted, cancels his/her admission to join any other course/institution not included in this prospectus he/she will forfeit his/her claim for re-admission or vertical mobility.
- 18.8 An applicant, who has been admitted to a particular course, later on changes his/her mind and does not take admission and again wants to join the same course, shall not be considered for re-admission in the same round of counselling.
- 18.9 The selection letter shall be issued only to the applicants selected for admission to a course of study on verification of original documents.

- (j) The selected candidates shall report to the Head of the College for admission on or before the specified date mentioned in the selection letter, failing which the admission shall stand cancelled and thereafter no request will be considered for re-admission.
- 18.10 The State Government reserves all rights to make any changes in the eligibility criteria, number of available seats, reservations, fee, charges and other conditions of admission in accordance with its policy, directions of the Courts, and regulations of the UGC and the H.P. Technical University without prior notice.
- 18.11 The candidate must produce the following documents, in original, along-with one photocopied set of certificates stapled separately and duly attested by a Gazetted Officer before the Admission Selection Committee at the time of counselling: -
  - (a) Certificate of having passed the matric examination.
  - (b) Certificate of having passed 10+2 examination.
  - (c) Marks-sheet issued by the Board/University in respect of the having passed matric and 10+2 examinations.
  - (d) Matriculation/Higher Secondary Part-I/Indian School Certificates showing the date of birth. No other certificate in respect of the date of birth will be entertained.
